The President of the Arkansas River Power Authority (ARPA) Board of Directors has called a special meeting of the Board on Friday, July 9, 2021, at 11:00 AM by Conference Call. The principal purpose will be to consider approval of a FERC related settlement. An executive session will be held for (1) the purpose of determining positions relative to matters that may be subject to negotiations, developing strategy for negotiations, and/or instructing negotiators, under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402(4)(e); and (2) for a conference with the General Counsel of the Authority for the purpose of receiving legal advice on specific legal questions under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402 (4)(b).

ARPA is a political subdivision of the state of Colorado, supplying wholesale electric power to its municipal members of Holly, La Junta, Lamar, Las Animas, Springfield and Trinidad, Colorado.
